HOUSING AND HUNGER CAN'T WAIT. THE NEED IS GROWING.

With 29% of Georgians unable to afford their rent, far too many live on the brink of disaster. When people must make sacrifices to afford housing, they often face food insecurity as well. More than 13% of Georgians (and 16% of Georgia children) were food insecure before COVID.

Now, bold action is required as the need for our services has skyrocketed since March. Calls for help have tripled at **HOPE Atlanta**, while the need for food assistance topped 800% at **Action Ministries**.

We're stronger together. **HOPE Atlanta** and **Action Ministries** can protect more vulnerable Georgians from hunger and homelessness while applying a holistic, individualized case management approach proven to address the root causes and promote lifelong stability.
